Dear Parents/Carers and Staff,

Updates

- We are sure you will be aware of the Government's most recent sudden announcement, to rollout mass testing for COVID-19 in Schools from January, starting with Secondary aged pupils in mainstream and special schools, before extending the programme to Primary aged pupils later in the year.
- We are waiting to receive further information from the Government and KCC regarding the logistics
 of how they envisage this working in practice. Nevertheless, we are being as proactive as we can at
 this point, by extensively researching testing procedures and guidelines, consulting with other
 professional bodies and drafting potential management plans. We will keep you up to date regarding
 future developments.
- The Government has indicated that most pupils should not attend School during the week of 4th January, to allow Schools to prepare for a phased return and for pupils to be "tested ahead of normal schooling resuming." However, the Government has also stated that "All specialist settings and alternative provision schools or settings should plan for full-time on-site provision for all pupils from the start of term." As we are a specialist setting, and all of our students have EHCPs, the staggered opening at the start of the New Year does not therefore apply to us.
- The Government has emphasised that "the children of critical workers.....are expected to access onsite education provision from each school's advertised first day of term and should be prioritised for
 testing." All of our staff are critical workers and are therefore expected to make the necessary
 arrangements to enable them to be available for work. Staff must liaise with their children's School
 as a matter of urgency in order to ensure that they secure prioritised provision for their child from
 4th January.
- The Government has advised that "Schools that wish to can use an extra INSET day on 4 January to prepare to deliver the testing". Due to the nature of the challenges we face in organising testing procedures, and the very short notice that we have been provided with, we will be taking up this offer.
 The 4th January will therefore be an INSET day for staff. We will re-open for pupils on Tuesday 5th January 2021.
- Our responsibilities for contact tracing continue through to the 23rd December. Please continue to liaise with our track and trace team if a pupil / staff member begins to present with symptoms or tests positive during this period trackandtrace@five-acre.kent.sch.uk
