Loose Site

As you aware, at the start of the Covid pandemic in March 2020, we temporarily adjusted the start of the School day and staggered the arrival of transport vehicles and parents / carers. This was done for social distancing purposes and it is a measure that we have kept in place until now.

Government guidance was updated in July 2021 and rules on social distancing have now been completely lifted.

After the October break (week commencing 1st November 2021) our opening time will therefore return to 9:15am for all pupils, and we will be removing the staggered arrival times that are currently in place. This will mean that all vehicles will be able to access the car park at the start / end of the day at once. Staff will receive pupils from 9:15am and pupils will be taken out to vehicles from 3:15pm at the end of the day.

Staff will continue to manage the flow of traffic to / from the site at the start and end of the day.

Resuming our 9:15am start will enable us to fully reinstate staff training and development prior to the School day, so that they can best support pupil achievement and needs. This will have a positive impact on your children.

We will therefore no longer be able to continue any informal early drop off arrangements that may previously have been agreed. Should any parents / carers require wrap around care provision at a cost, please feel free to get in touch with us to explore the feasibility of this paid for service.
