

There are 10 pupils in Birchwood class. Our timetable focuses around doing functional everyday activities such as cooking, washing, cleaning and social situations.

We have weekly visits to Tutsham Farm, Communigrow and swimming. Pupils enjoy accessing the local community and working at the community allotment.

We focus on well-being sports and regularly mix with the other sixth form classes to play Boccia, basketball and attend a weekly boxing lesson.

A key focus for the start of the year is 'understanding money'. Pupils explore real money, what they can buy and using money in the local community, such as ordering and buying a snack at the cafe. We also focus on everyday living skills. Ashwood, Birchwood and Hazelwood classes merge together to enable the pupils to work in small groups to access all activities.
