The 30 minute appointments should be booked via the STLS Administrator, Tracey Bradley, <u>tbradley@five-acre.kent.sch.uk</u>. As it is possible to have Specialist Teachers from more than one dimension and/or SALT attending the same meeting, please specify the particular need(s) you wish to discuss when booking your appointment so Tracey can allocate the appropriate staff.

To discuss a pupil with the SALT Team, please complete their <u>consent form</u>. C/YP being discussed with the STLS Team are kept anonymous, which means no paperwork or consent is required. Specialist Teachers will provide schools with an email summary of the recommendations.

To ensure Specialist Teachers and SALT provide SENCos with appropriate advice and recommendations, they will need to find out as much as possible about the pupil(s) being discussed. To help them do this, please endeavour to have the information detailed below to hand at the meeting.
