

Badger class has 10 pupils aged 6 to 8 years, supported by 4 members of staff. Badger class are within the Structured learning approach, which means we follow a TEACCH rotation in class consisting of 1:1 work, workstation, group work and leisure/ outside learning time. Each pupil follows their own individual schedule to guide them through their day and to foster independence in moving from one activity to another. This consistent approach to our learning helps us to develop confidence and independence in learning about the world around us.

We incorporate the 'Zones of Regulation' in our daily routine, to support emotional regulation and becoming more independent. Badger class work on activities that help us to develop communication, self-regulation, independence, life skills and that link closely with our EHCP targets. Some of our favourite class sessions include Attention Autism, engaging with art and craft-based activities and cookery.
