



Bat class is within the Structured learning approach. There is 1 Class Teacher, 1 Senior Teaching Assistant and 3 Teaching Assistants. There are 10 pupils in class whose ages range from 6 – 8 years old.

Pupils follow the TEACCH approach, which involves 1:1 teaching, group work, independent workstations, leisure and outdoor learning. This enables them to learn in a number of different ways, such as a visual, physical, kinaesthetic and auditory. We help pupils to become more independent and to support their emotional regulation by incorporating the Zones of Regulation in their daily routines. Pupils undertake enrichment activities, such as going to soft play, cooking, art and visiting the sensory garden and the field for physical activities. Each term, the learning approach focus on a topic and pupils complete a variety of activities based around this.

We look forward to the year ahead in Bat class and to supporting pupils with their emerging independence. We are excited to see them evolve emotionally, develop a greater understanding of the world around them and above all, watch them flourish.
