

Beaver class has 9 pupils ranging from year 4 to year 7. They are supported by a class team who work with them in a rotation of group work, 1:1 and independent work; all of these have an area of leisure in between to ensure the pupils can make the best progress possible.

Initially, the class team will be working on settling pupils into their new class routines, helping them to learn how to self-regulate and self-occupy throughout the day, as well as how best to communicate their wants and needs to others. Individually, pupils will work on specific activities that support their EHCP outcomes and personal development.

Each week, small groups will take part in 'Attention Autism', 'Sensory Circuits', 'Write Dance', 'HandyPac' and 'Dough Disco'. Pupils will be completing speech and development activities, mark making and a range of activities that develop the curiosity in their development daily. They will all have access to well-resourced outside activities and be able to learn outside throughout the day, including forest school activities. Pupils will develop their life skills through a variety of planned walks. They will be having lots of fun every day and will have the opportunity to take part in performances for parents and carers.
