Pupils are working towards accreditations linked to their functional pathway. They transition to a variety of learning areas within the school and in the local community, where they access the curriculum areas offered within their learning pathway. They enjoy learning, taking part in problems solving activities and discussions where they share their ideas and support each other. They develop life skills and functional skills to develop their independence and confidence to take an active role in their immediate and wider communities.

Pupils continue to develop their growth mindset to help them to manage future challenges with greater confidence. They enjoy celebrating each other's achievements and are encouraged to display a positive attitude in line with the school values.

Pupils are working towards embracing the world outside of school, learning about workplace expectations and future independent or assisted home life settings. Standards are set in school during practical work, work experience and during functional learning in class. Pupils focus on developing literacy and numeracy functional skills, speaking and listening skills and on building their confidence when engaging with an audience during assembly time and during practical work.
