



Elm class are a key stage 3 class within the Formal learning approach and are based at the Snodland site. There are 17 pupils and 3 members of staff. Pupils work in similar ability or mixed ability groups, depending on the lesson or task.

Each week, the class move around the school to different teachers and classes to participate in specific lessons of maths, English, creative arts, PE, science, PSHE, ICT and humanities. Once a week they develop their preparation for adulthood, learning skills such as cooking, employment, independent living, animal care and working at the allotment. We focus on building confidence, teamwork and social skills.

Working together with parents is important and we encourage parents to engage with us and the learning process by regularly reading at home, supporting homework when given and through regular contact via the class Teams page.
