



Fox class has 6 pupils from year 2 to year 5. There are 4 adults in class; a Class Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant and 2 Teaching Assistants.

Fox class is within the Structured learning approach, which means we follow a TEACCH rotation in class consisting of 1:1 work, workstation, group work and leisure time. We use this rotation to help us understand our day and what is expected of us. We work on activities that help us develop our communication, self-regulation, independence and life skills. As a class, we follow the engagement model principles, which allows the adults to use each individual pupil's learning strategy to tune into their bespoke needs.

Fox class enjoy being in the sensory garden, participating in messy play activities, 'What's in the bag?', massage and foot spa sessions.

During the year we are looking forward to developing our engagement and attention skills to help us to achieve our EHCP targets. We are also looking forward to building relationships with each other and working on our independence.
