



Lynx class is within the Structured learning approach. In class there are 11 pupils between the ages of 7 to 9 years, a Class Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant and 2 Teaching Assistants. Our class routine is tailored to the pupils' specific EHCP targets, to help them to make the best possible progress. Pupils work towards developing independence and building relationship with others through understanding emotions and practising social skills. We like to work in partnership with parents.

Pupils in Lynx class follow a TEACCH programme, which means that they work in a daily rotation format of small group work tasks, independent workstations and structured leisure time. Pupils have 1:1 learning input from staff to monitor their progress and their personal needs.

Pupils focus daily on communication, literacy skills and developing mathematical skills and reasoning. Lessons are specific to the termly topic to motivate pupils and expose them to a wide range of experiences. This includes outdoor and indoor learning opportunities, such as soft play, cooking, horticulture, PE. Lynx pupils love to be active and creative. They enjoy outdoor activities, colouring, handwriting, sensory and messy play. Music and songs are incorporated into the daily routine to make learning enjoyable and interesting. We are looking forward to a great year ahead.
