

Sparrow class has 12 pupils with ages ranging from 12-15 years old. They are supported by a Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant and 3 Teaching Assistants.

The primary focus of our learning is to provide pupils with as much independence as possible for later in life, so that they have the necessary skills to help them to lead an independent life.

The Practical learning approach work closely with pupils to improve their independence, communication and confidence and to provide real life experiences. They also practise living skills, literacy, numeracy, topic, Attention Autism, phonics, reading, art and sensory circuits.

Pupils have the chance to experience an array of opportunities including visiting the community on a regular basis, weekly horticulture and cooking lessons and looking after the many animals we have on the school site, including goats, chickens, quail, rabbits and pigs.
