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# AIMS

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- To provide support and advice to parents/carers to create and ensure a consistent approach between home and school
- To work in partnership with parents/carers, on a range of topics

### HOW DOES 'TEAM' Work

- TEAM consists of school staff with a varied range of experiences and expertise, providing support to parents/carers, teachers and TA's
- We cover a wide range of topics, some of which include:

Attendance— Support for you and your child coming to school, which may include during difficult transitions or returning from a medical procedure

**Signpost service**—providing information relating to recommended external services to meet a specific need

**Meetings**— attending meetings alongside parents and carers, as a school representative

Parenting and behaviour—support to identify and address issues at home

Using visual aids—modelling the use of them and how they can have a positive impact on home life



### WHAT WILL THE SCHOOL DO?

#### We will:

- Invite you into school to meet with a member of TEAM, and or other professionals, for a primary discussion
- Listen to you and your child in order to identify the correct level of support for the issues raised
- Provide specific support, through discussions or training opportunities, such as guidance on behaviour strategies or structured systems and support tools used within the school setting
- Create and provide materials and demonstrate how to use them (if applicable)
- Make a referral to outside services (if applicable)



## WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO?

#### You should be willing to:

- Attend an initial meeting to discuss any problems or issues that you may be experiencing
- Want and accept school support
- Be committed to working towards achieving the agreed target/ end goal
- Attempt new ways of working with your child at home
