



Nurture Nest encourages and develops pupil's self-esteem, to face learning challenges with more confidence, to be compassionate, respectful and to have an enhanced sense of identity and belonging within their classroom environment.

Class staff aim to support pupils with social, emotional and behaviour difficulties, who struggle to be in class. They also aim to replace missing early years experiences, by developing positive relationships with both Teachers and peers in a supportive environment. This is a short-term intervention for pupils across the Loose site. The aim is to resettle pupils in class within 2-4 terms.

A typical day in Nurture Nest may include taking part in Theraplay, messy play, horticulture, sensory circuits, Lego therapy and other activities.
