



In Ravel class there are 10 pupils supported by a Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant and 3 Teaching Assistants. We learn through using the TEACCH approach where we complete 1:1, group and independent activities with a leisure period in between each area of work. We use lots of visuals to support us in class including individual schedules which tell us what we are doing throughout the day, communication boards and choosing boards. Pupils will be engaging in activities that specifically focus on their EHCP targets as well as focusing on their personal, social and emotional development.

We enjoy lots of messy play in Ravel class. We are hands on with our learning and enjoy sensory activities. In small groups we will engage with Attention Autism, Sensory Circuits, Write Dance, HandyPac and Dough Disco. Pupils have access to a well-resourced outside area to enable them to learn in outdoor environments. We will be exploring in the sensory garden and having horticulture sessions to ensure learning is taking place in a variety of settings.

We are focusing on project based learning this year and will be holding an art gallery, a camping experience on school site, lots of travelling in the community as well as many other activities. We are keen and enthusiastic within our learning and we are looking forward to completing these projects throughout the year.
