



Beckham class is a key stage 2 class within the Practical learning approach. There are 11 pupils in class, together with one Class Teacher, one Senior Teaching Assistant and 2 Teaching Assistants.

In the Practical learning approach, pupils learn through real-world experiences and structured play. Where possible, the class staff try to relate the learning to each child's individual experiences and their teaching approaches reflect the learning styles of all pupils in class.

Over the year, Beckham class will focus on a variety of topics, starting with 'Look in the mirror' which involves the pupils learning all about themselves. In term 2 we will focus on 'Events around the world'. In term 3 our topic will be 'Field, farm, fork', which is learning about food. Our focus in term 4 is 'Bang, crash, wallop', followed by 'Once upon a time' in term 5. We will finish the year with 'We are all going on a summer holiday' in term 6.

All of our learning forms a basis to promoting independence, life skills and social interactions. The class team hope to be able to embed this learning through accessing the wider school environment and taking trips out into the community.
