Our **priority during the day is to teach and support our pupils**, so we won't always be able to answer you straight away. We aim to answer emails and Teams messages within two working days.

If you need to speak to us urgently, please call reception who will direct your enquiry.

For other important incidents, such as closures or traffic issues, we will send a text, app alert or add information to the website and social media, so please keep an eye out.
