



Edison class has 11 students who are learning through practical and functional learning to prepare them for adulthood once they leave 6th Form and move to their prospective next provisions. They will be taught how to keep themselves safe whilst cooking, to use the washing machine and load the dishwasher.

Students will learn how to budget and use money correctly, paying for items as well as ensuring they have sufficient funds to pay for them. They will manoeuvre in the wider community through travel training, accessing public transport, walking to closer locations or accessing amenities such as local leisure centres, libraries or work placements. Students will continue their learning with regards to personal health and hygiene. Students will be supported to continue their development to live as independently as possible.

Students will participate in cooking and life skills lessons, travel training, work skills, swimming lessons and PE and will continue to develop functional skills.
