

Jordan class is within the Practical learning approach. There are 9 pupils in class who are supported by a Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant and two Teaching Assistants.

In the Practical learning approach, pupils learn through real-world experiences. Wherever possible, we link learning to each pupil's individual experiences, using a range of teaching strategies that reflect the learning styles of all pupils in the class.

Throughout the year, pupils will take part in a wide variety of engaging sensory and practical opportunities designed to develop their communication and interaction skills. They will also access a broad range of community experiences, such as shopping, café visits and leisure activities. Some of our pupils are in year 9 and are working towards ASDAN Life Skills accreditation through real-life experiences.

Jordan class are a 'hands-on' group who love using all of their senses when exploring and learning. We will begin the year with the theme 'Me and my future', before moving on to a variety of other topics linked to wider experiences of the world. Wherever possible, we aim to embed this learning by exploring the wider school environment and taking trips out into the community.
