



Orwell class is a secondary class based at the Snodland satellite site with 14 pupils ranging from 12 – 14 years. They are supported by the Class Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant and 2 Teaching Assistants.

This year the focus is to encourage confidence and independence in all areas. Pupils are grouped with peers of all abilities so that they can share learning e.g. in terms of discussion or scribing and peer discussion/marking of work.

Over the course of this year, they will transition from class to class, developing their knowledge and understanding in subjects such as English, maths, science, humanities, creative arts and PE. They will be exploring life skills through Preparation for Adulthood classes. Life skills are an intrinsic part of the curriculum with regular trips to spend planned budgets on shopping, cooking simple meals and visiting our allotment.
