

Tolstoy class are based at our Snodland site and follow the Secondary Formal learning approach. The class consists of 15 pupils and 4 staff members.

This year, pupils will continue to follow a secondary school structure, moving around the site to learn from different teachers across a range of subjects. A key focus will be on developing maturity, building independence and strengthening teamwork skills, taking in our key values of respect, empathy, consideration and kindness. In Preparation for Adulthood lessons, pupils will learn valuable life skills such as cooking a variety of meals, budgeting, gardening, volunteering and taking part in work opportunities within the school and the wider community. In English and maths, pupils will continue to build their knowledge and understanding of key concepts in preparation for Functional Skills exams in the coming years.

Tolstoy class are an active and enthusiastic group who enjoy playing games and taking part in a wide range of sports. In class there are some talented chess players and several pupils with strong artistic skills.
