



Williams class is within the Practical learning approach. There are 11 pupils in class with ages ranging from 6 to 9 years. Pupils are supported by a team of 3 adults, including a Class Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant and a Cover Teaching Assistant.

We focus on 'hands-on', engaging activities that help pupils to build essential life skills in a meaningful and supportive way. Whether it is cooking, role play, or using tools, every session is designed to meet individual needs, whilst encouraging independence, communication and confidence.

In literacy, we use 'Colourful Semantics' to support sentence building and language development. In numeracy, we use manipulatives, such as counting cubes, number lines and tactile resources, to make abstract concepts more easier to comprehend. These strategies ensure that learning is interactive, inclusive and tailored to each pupil's strengths.
