



Britten class is within the Structured learning approach and consists of 8 pupils, a Class Teacher, a Teaching Assistant and a Cover Teaching Assistant. The pupils ages range from 8 to 9 years.

We follow the TEACHH approach, which involves 1:1 teaching, group work, independent workstations, leisure and outdoor learning. This enables pupils to learn in a number of different ways, such as a visual, physical, kinaesthetic and auditory. Pupils are encouraged to become more independent and class staff support their emotional regulation by incorporating the Zones of Regulation into their daily routines.

Pupils undertake enrichment activities, such as going to Soft-Play, the Trim Trail, class cooking and art, as well as visiting the MUGA and the field for physical activities. Each term, the learning approach focus on a topic and complete a variety of activities based around it.

We look forward to the year ahead and to supporting pupils with their emerging independence. We believe in a solid home/school relationship and work to establish outstanding bonds with families. We are excited to see the pupils evolve emotionally, develop a greater understanding of the world around them and above all, watching them flourish.
