



Chopin class is within the Structured learning approach. In class there are 11 pupils, who are supported by a Class Teacher and 2 Teaching Assistants. The pupils' ages range from 7 to 8 years old.

We learn using the TEACCH approach where we complete 1:1 sessions, workstation tasks to promote independence, group work to aid social skills and communication development and leisure/ outdoor activities for self-regulation. We use lots of visuals to support us in class including individual schedules, which tell us what we are doing throughout the day, communication boards and choosing boards. Pupils will be engaging in activities that specifically focus on their EHCP targets, as well as focusing on their personal, social and emotional development.

Pupils also participate in extra enrichment activities, such as going to soft-play, the trim trail, class cooking, art, as well as visiting our Forest School area. Each term, our Structured learning approach focus on a topic and we complete a variety of activities based around these topics.

We look forward to the year ahead in Chopin class and to supporting pupils with their emerging independence. We believe in a solid home/school relationship and work to establish outstanding bonds with our families. We are excited to see our pupils evolve emotionally, develop a greater understanding of the world around them and above all, watching them flourish.
