



Haydn class consists of 8 pupils, aged 10–11 years. There are 3 members of staff in the class; a Class Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant and a Teaching Assistant. Haydn class follows a Structured learning approach, catering to each pupil's individual needs. Pupils learn using the TEACCH approach, engaging in 1:1, group and independent activities, with a leisure period in between each area of work.

Visual supports are extensively used in class, including individual schedules that outline each pupil's day, communication boards and choice boards. Pupils participate in activities that specifically focus on their EHCP targets, alongside their personal, social and emotional development. They particularly enjoy sensory and messy play and love spending time outdoors in the sensory garden. Engaging in these activities helps them to develop their life skills and independence.
