



Ravel class consists of 9 pupils who are supported by a Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant and 3 Teaching Assistants. We follow the TEACCH approach, engaging in 1:1, group and independent activities, with leisure periods between each area of work to support regulation and focus.

We use a range of visual supports in the classroom, including individual schedules, communication boards and choosing boards, to help pupils understand and anticipate their routines throughout the day. Activities are designed to target each pupil's EHCP outcomes, alongside promoting personal, social, and emotional development.

We love messy play in Ravel class. Our learning is 'hands-on' and sensory-rich. In small groups, pupils take part in Attention Autism, Sensory Circuits, Write Dance, Massage and Dough Disco sessions.

Pupils have access to a well-resourced outdoor area, where they can explore learning opportunities in different environments. This includes the sensory garden and horticulture sessions, providing varied and engaging experiences.

This year, we are focusing on project-based learning, which will include exciting events such as hosting an art gallery, a school-based camping experience and regular outings in the community. We are enthusiastic learners and look forward to engaging in these exciting projects throughout the year.
