

Tchaikovsky class is within the Structured learning approach, with 9 pupils aged 9 to 10 years. They are supported by 3 members of staff.

Pupils follow the TEACCH approach, where pupils learn through a mixture of workstations, group activities, 1:1 sessions, leisure and outdoor learning. Our focus is on numeracy, literacy, enrichment, and working towards outcomes including personal and social development, communication and independence.

Communication is supported in many ways, including signing, speech, visual supports and personalised communication aids, so that every pupil is able participate and communicate effectively.

Learning in Tchaikovsky class is 'hands-on' and practical. Pupils engage in lots of sensory exploration, art, music and Attention Autism, alongside opportunities for physical activity on the trim trail, in soft play and outside on the MUGA. Each term we explore a different topic, learning through a wide variety of meaningful and engaging activities.
